Ordinance 2023-7

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-23 'RATES' OF ARTICLE II 'WATER SUPPLY AND DISTRIBUTION' OF CHAPTER 12 'MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AND SERVICES' OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF ST. FRANCISVILLE, STATE OF LOUISIANA.

Section 12-23 "Rates" of Article II "Water Supply and Distribution" of Chapter 12 "Municipal Utilities and Services" of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of St. Francisville, State of Louisiana, hereby is amended to specify water rates of the municipality to read as follows:

"Section 12-23 Rates

The water rates of the municipality, effective immediately, shall be as follows:

Residential Customer, in town limits

\$22.00 minimum bill for the first 2,000 gallons

\$3.75 per 1,000 gallons all excess

Residential Customer, outside of town limits

\$22.00 minimum bill for the first 2,000 gallons

\$4.00 per 1,000 gallons all excess

Small Business Customer, defined as a commercial establishment whose usage is less than 10,000 gallons a month.

\$27.00 minimum bill for the first 2,000 gallons

\$3.75 per 1,000 gallons all excess

Large Business Customer, defined as a commercial establishment whose usage exceeds 10,000 gallons a month.

\$62.00 minimum bill for the first 2,000 gallons

\$3.75 per 1,000 gallons all excess

Rates for all customers shall be adjusted annually based on the "Consumer Price Index (CPI)" Approval up to 3% can be granted by the Mayor and the Town Clerk, greater than 3% shall go to the Town Council. This adjustment will go into effect on July 1st annually.

BE IT ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become effective upon passage by the Board of Aldermen.
