DECLARATION

STATE OF EMERGENCY

TOWN OF SAINT FRANCISVILLE

PARISH OF WEST FELICIANA

WHEREAS, The Town of Saint Francisville, in the Parish of West Feliciana, State of Louisiana, is presently faced with an emergency/disaster situation due to the impending arrival of Hurricane Francine expected to make landfall on the coast of Louisiana on or about September 11, 2024 as a possible Category Two or higher hurricane, causing high winds and heavy rains, probable flooding and possible tornado activity; and

WHEREAS, there is a very definite threat to life and property of the citizens and residents of the Town of St. Francisville; and

WHEREAS, persons evacuating the southern coastal areas of the State of Louisiana are expected to arrive in the Town of St. Francisville causing an additional burden thereon; and

WHEREAS, Emergency action must be taken to protect all persons and property;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Robert P. Leake, Jr. Mayor of St. Francisville, by the authority vested in me by the Louisiana Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act, R.S. 29:721, et seq., do hereby proclaim the following:

A STATE OF EMERGENCY does exist within the town of St. Francisville. All emergency plans must be activated and the necessary actions be taken.
