HOW BUSINESS APPLY FOR ALCOHOL PERMIT

- 1) Complete Application of Alcoholic Beverage Permit for the Town of St. Francisville & pay the permit fee.
- 2) Receive and review a copy of the Alcohol Ordinances.
- 3) Submit a NOTARIZED COPY of the SCHEDULE A FORM for every individual of the company that owns more than 5 percent of the capitol stock.
- 4) Have your legal notice of intent to sell alcohol published in the Town's official journal.
 - a) <u>Complete the Alcoholic Beverage Permit Note</u> and return it to The Advocate. Contact numbers for The Advocate are attached for your convenience.
 - b) The Town of St. Francesville's liquor permit ordinance states that the publication of legal notice of intent to sell liquor has to be <u>published two (2)</u> times in the Town's official journal which is the ADVOCATE EXTRA.
 - c) You will need to <u>request an affidavit of publication</u> from THE ADVOCATE showing that the Legal Notices have been published 2 times.
- 5) If the building is being rented, you will need to provide a copy of the lease to the Town.
- 6) Once the Town has received the following items, the request for Alcohol Permit will be placed on the Agenda.
 - Permit Application and Permit fee
 - Notarized Schedule A Forms
 - Copy of Lease (For Renters Only)
 - Affidavit of Publication

If approved by the Board and payment has been received, an Alcohol Permit will be issued.
